

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION CRITERIA AND PLACEMENT SCORES

1. Group A - Students applying from Azerbaijan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan, Afghanistan and Tajikistan can only apply with TR-YÖS exam scores.

2. Group B - Students applying from Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Albania, Barbados, Bolivia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Falkland Islands, French Guiana, Guatemala, Guyana, India, Honduras, Iran, Montenegro, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Macedonia, Moldova, Nicaragua, Pakistan, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Puerto Rico, Serbia, Suriname, Chile, Trinidad and Tobago, Uruguay, Venezuela, Kosovo must have TR-YÖS, diploma grades or scores from national exams.

3. Group C – USA, Germany, Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Belarus, United Kingdom, Bulgaria, Algeria, Czech Republic, China, Hong Kong SAR China, Macau SAR China, Denmark, Indonesia, Estonia, Morocco, Finland, France, Cyprus, South Korea, Croatia, Netherlands, Iraq, Ireland, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Italy, Iceland, Japan, Canada, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malaysia, Malta, Isle of Man, Mexico, Egypt, Mongolia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Russia, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Syria, Tunisia, Uzbekistan, New Zealand and Greece.

4. Group D – For Angola, Bahrain, Western Sahara, Benin, United Arab Emirates, Botswana, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Gibraltar, Djibouti, Chad, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Ivory Coast, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, South Africa, South Sudan, Israel, Cameroon, Qatar, Kenya, Congo - Brazzaville, Congo - Kinshasa, Kuwait, Liberia, Libya, Lebanon, Madagascar, Malawi, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Namibia, Niger, Nigeria, Central African Republic, Rwanda, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Saudi Arabia, Tanzania, Togo, Uganda, Oman, Jordan, Yemen, Zambia, Zimbabwe, TR-YÖS or Baccalaureate exam score is required.

5. Group E - For all remaining countries, TR-YÖS, International and National Higher Education Entrance Exam score or national diploma score is required as a priority.

6. TR-YÖS is accepted as a priority in countries where TR-YÖS is conducted.

7. Students who graduated from Turkish Maarif Foundation schools can apply with TR-YÖS, National Exam and Diploma score regardless of the country requirement.

Calculation Formulas for International Exams

1. TRYÖS: $T = 100(y-100)/400$

2. SAT: $T = 100(y-400)/1200$

3. Baccalaureate: $T = y * 5$

4. ACT: 100-point conversion table announced by ACT (ANNEX1)

5. ABİTUR: $T = 100(y-300) / 600$
